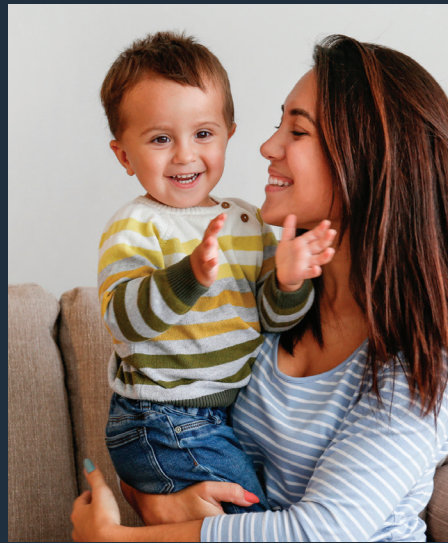


Coming Soon: Perinatal Treatment Center



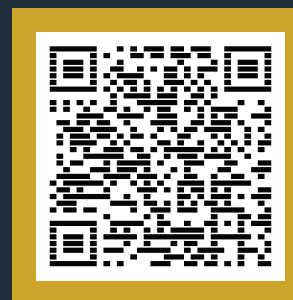
Janus was recently awarded a Behavioral Health Continuum Infrastructure Program (BHCIP) facilities grant. This grant will fund the construction of a new 25-bed residential treatment center for women (who can live with their children up to age 12 on site) in Watsonville, set to open in September 2026. The new Janus Women and Families Recovery Center / Centro de Recuperación de Mujeres y Familias will address the significant need for treatment beds, especially for Latina women in the community.

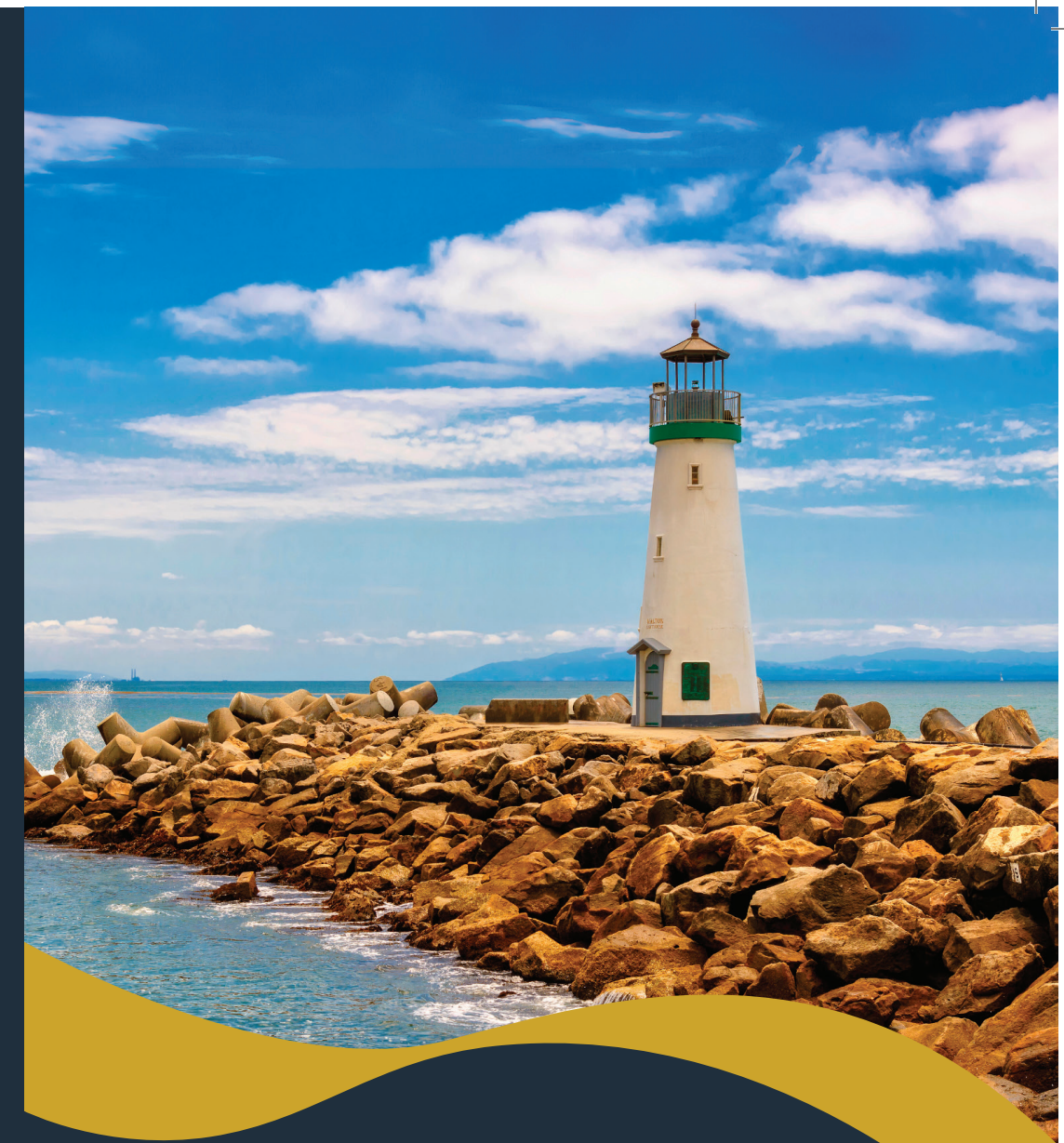

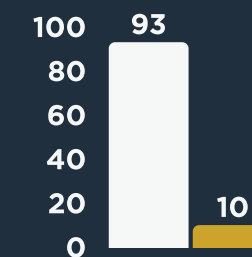

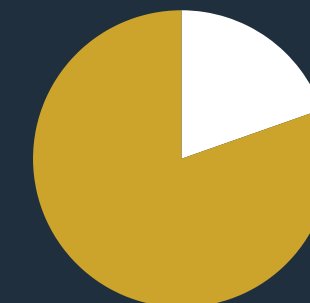
