Janus offers a residential treatment program that serves women who are pregnant or parenting children ages 17 and younger. The program's primary goal is to support both mother and child in their recovery, allowing children up to five years of age to live with their mothers throughout their stay at Janus. The Length of stay is based on regular assessments and tailored to individual needs for real results.

Our Perinatal program is an intensive combination of group, individual, and family treatment, housed in Janus' Center for Women and Children. Although specific to substance use disorders, the program also provides care coordination for the treatment of coexisting physical or psychiatric conditions as needed.
